Are there any **safety** concerns with Dasuquin®?

The ingredients in Dasuquin have been evaluated in a safety study in cats, and no adverse effects were noted from usage. There are no known contraindications or known interactions between Dasuquin and any drug or supplement.

How is Dasuquin used?

Dasuquin is available in sprinkle capsules containing a tasty powder that can be sprinkled over food, or may be used in capsule form if more convenient.

The recommended initial use period is 4-6 weeks. Once desired response is obtained, capsules may be taken every other day to maintain joint health. Changes in your cat's comfort level may occur gradually; allow time for your cat to respond.

	# of Sprinkle Capsules – Initial 4-6 Weeks	# of Sprinkle Capsules – Suggested Maintenance
Cats 10 lbs & Over	2 per day	2 every other day or 1 per day
Cats Under 10 lbs	1 per day	1 every other day

Number of capsules given may be increased at any time depending on your cat's needs.

Bladder Support

Some veterinarians may also recommend Dasuquin to help maintain urinary bladder health. The inner lining of the bladder wall is protected by a layer containing some of the same compounds found in cartilage. The chondroitin sulfate (CS) found in Dasuquin may help support this protective layer.
